Conference Manual

Dress Code: Western Business Attire

Structure:

There will be three 120-minute sessions and one 90-minute session, during which you should cover the following four phases:

- I. **Diagnostics:** What are the main problems areas within the topic?
- II. **Priorities:** Which of these issues are most urgent?
- III. **Proposals:** How can we best address these challenges?
- IV. **Evaluation:** What are the limitations of these proposals?

Depending on the progress of the discussion, the moderator may modify the length of each phase.

The Debate

Committee discussions will generally follow **formal debate procedure**. Participants must raise their hands and be recognized by the moderator of their respective working group in order to speak. Once a potential speaker is recognized he/she will have one to two minutes to state their point.

As the debate moves forward and participants begin to find common ground, a conference participant may request an **informal debate**. If the moderator approves the request, participants will receive ten to fifteen minutes to assemble informally and begin writing the policy proposals. We recommend that participants make this request once per session so that they can organize their ideas and conclusions into writing.

Special Positions

At the beginning of the debate, each moderator will appoint a **secretary**. This person will be responsible for summarizing the main ideas of each speaker and for writing out the policy proposal. Each secretary will be allowed to bring a laptop for convenience.

By the end of the last working group session on Saturday, April 2nd, each working group must have selected one **representative** to present the group's conclusions to all conference participants during the "Group Presentations" session that afternoon.

If the group participants fail to reach a consensus, the moderator shall select the representative.

Considerations

We would like to remind our conference participants to respect the points of view of others during the debates. The purpose of Plan País is to create a forum where participants can exchange ideas and incorporate each other's opinions into a policy brief. Finally, please also be considerate of your speaking time so that everyone has the opportunity to be heard.
